LUNENBURG



Eurocentres Atlantic Canada is located in beautiful Lunenburg, Nova Scotia – a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of Canada’s most beautiful places. Established in 1753, Lunenburg is full of history and rich in culture.

Lunenburg is a safe community with no crime and is the ideal location for young students who are away from home for the first time. Eurocentres students often enjoy exploring the coastal community and spending time on the scenic waterfront which is home to the famous racing schooner, the Bluenose!

Lunenburg’s harbour-side streets are lined with unique shops and restaurants that blend with the well-preserved and colorfully painted historic homes, much of it like a living museum from the 18th century. It is truly a magical place to spend your summer – we look forward to meeting you!



CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

"BRIGHTLY COLORED HISTORIC homes dot the south shore of Nova Scotia on the edge of the Atlantic Ocean like a nautical postcard from the past. Since the 1700s, a mix of European immigrants have called the 47-block town, located 60 miles from Halifax, home. Each wave of newcomers has influenced the food, culture, and architecture, making downtown Lunenburg, now dotted with galleries and shops, a National Historic and UNESCO World Heritage site. In this port community of fishermen and shipbuilders, the waters guided their livelihood then and now."

A beloved part of Canadian history is part of Lunenburg, NS. In 1921, the internationally known ship the Bluenose launched from the shores of Lunenburg. As a racing ship, it went undefeated for seventeen years, and even appears on Canadian currency!



Lunenburg is bursting with art! About 10% of the town's businesses are related to the arts in some fashion. There are several art galleries, art and pottery studios, and art events like the Lunenburg Festival of Crafts and the Lunenburg Street Festival & Art Walk along with a constant stream of music and entertainment throughout the weeks.



IMMERSIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE

Almost 250 years after the original Lunenburg was established, the architecture and common space use remain intact. Any new construction complements the existing design and layout. In 1995 The United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) placed Lunenburg on its World Heritage List. The honor is immortalized in an eight-foot granite and bronze monument cast at Lunenburg Foundry. Lunenburg's pride, like its hospitality, knows no bounds.
